Overview

27 crimes recorded/reported.

Only 2 of the above were serious acquisitive crimes (SAC: Burglary, Auto crime & Robbery).

Of the 27 crimes, 17 suspects have been identified.

A total of 3 arrests were made in connection with these offences.

1 suspect has been charged for court.

1 community resolution disposal was issued.

The above stats are subject to change, due to enquiries being ongoing for a number of offences, so for example this may lead to further arrests or suspects being charged.

August Crime (Breakdown)

Vehicle crime (TFMV, TOMV, TWOC & VI)

Theft of motor vehicle – Holcutt Cl. Vehicle stolen off of driveway by unknown means.

Theft of motor vehicle – Elm Grove. Vehicle stolen off of driveway by unknown means.

Theft / Shoplifting / Make off without payment

Shoplifting – Newport Pagnell Rd. health & beauty products stolen.

Theft of pedal cycle

Theft of pedal cycle – Pedal cycle stolen from recreation ground by unknown person.

Violence

Affray/offences against state – Suspect intentionally/recklessly causes a nuisance in a public place, suspect identified/arrested, investigation ongoing.

Assault with injury – Staff assaulted, suspect identified although NFA as victim withdraws support.

Assault with injury – Victim assaulted, suspect identified although NFA as victim withdraws support.

Assault without injury - Staff assaulted, suspect identified although NFA as victim withdraws support.

Criminal damage

Crim damage (other bldgs) – Wootton Community centre. Damaged to toilets by 5 unknown teenage girls.

Criminal damage other – Criminal damage caused to home, suspect identified although NFA as victim withdraws support.

Criminal damage other – Roadside furniture has been spray painted by unknow person.

Criminal damage other – Damage caused to internal doors & banister at a address.

Racially or religiously aggravated criminal damage – Item thrown at victims window.

Drugs

Possession cont drugs cannabis – Suspect identified, community resolution disposal issued.

Possession of articles with blade or point – Suspect identified, investigation ongoing.

NFA = No Further Action

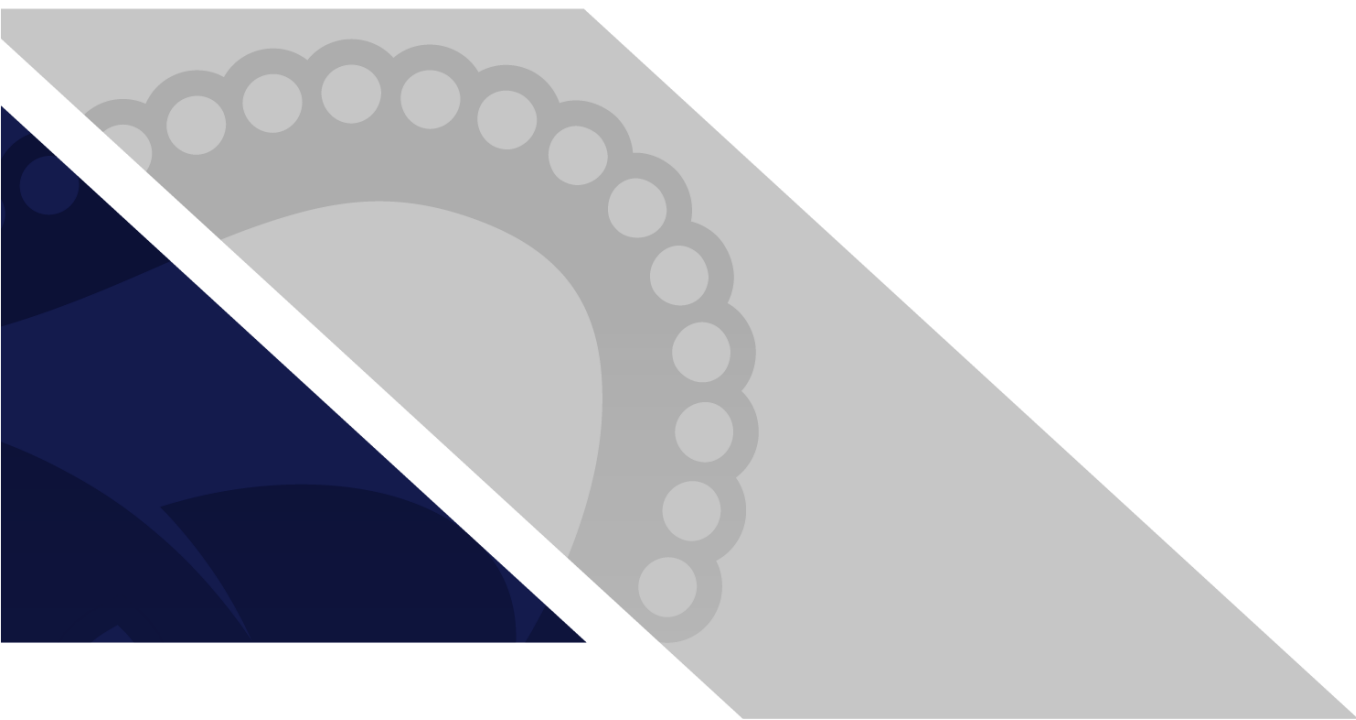
RUI = Released Under Investigation
