

Wootton October crime report

Date: 4th November 2024



Overview

17 crimes recorded/reported.

None of the crimes were serious acquisitive crimes (SAC: Burglary, Auto crime & Robbery). Of the 17 crimes, 12 suspects have been identified.

A total of 3 arrests were made in connection with these offences.

The below breakdown doesn't include the details of domestic crime & sexual offences. The reason behind this is due to their sensitive nature – however the data is included in the above figures

The above stats are subject to change, due to enquiries being ongoing for a number of offences, so for example this may lead to further arrests or suspects being charged.

October Crime (Breakdown)

Theft / Shoplifting / Make off without payment

Shoplifting – Newport Pagnell Rd. Alcohol stolen from store.

Theft(other) – Parcel stolen from doorstep.

Theft(other) – Theft of basket full of sweets stolen from doorstep.

Violence

Assault with injury – Victim grabbed, suspect identified, NFA as victim withdraws support. Assault with injury – Victim grabbed/pushed, suspect identified, NFA due to evidential difficulties.

Assault without injury – Victim placed in headlock & kicked, suspect identified, investigation ongoing.

Criminal damage

Crim damage to dwellings – Front door damaged, NFA as no further lines of enquiry. Criminal damage to vehs -Car scratched by unknown object/offender.

Possession of bladed article/weapon

Possession of articles with blade or point – Suspect is alleged to have pulled out a small knife following a disagreement, investigation ongoing.



Public Order

Affray/offences against state – Suspect causes public nuisance, suspect is identified/arrested, NFA due to evidential difficulties.

Glossary

NFA = No Further Action **RUI** = Released Under Investigation **TOMV** = Theft of Motor Vehicle

TFMV = Theft From Motor Vehicle **CDMV** = Criminal damage to Motor Vehicle **TWOC** = Taken Without Owners Consent
